Nurse Support Workers: RCN regulations for the RCN Nurse Support Workers Constituency

At the RCN AGM on 26 October 2011, RCN members voted to amend the RCN Standing Orders to give health practitioners, such as health care assistants and assistant practitioners, full membership of the RCN and provide two seats for them on RCN Council.

At the RCN AGM on 20 May 2019, RCN members voted to amend the RCN Standing Orders to change the name of Health Practitioners to Nursing Support Workers. This regulation has been updated to reflect the change of name.

In order to implement this, two regulations were agreed by RCN Council on 9 February 2012, These

a) define the Nursing Support Workers constituency.

and

b) defines the committee to represent Nursing Support Worker members.
