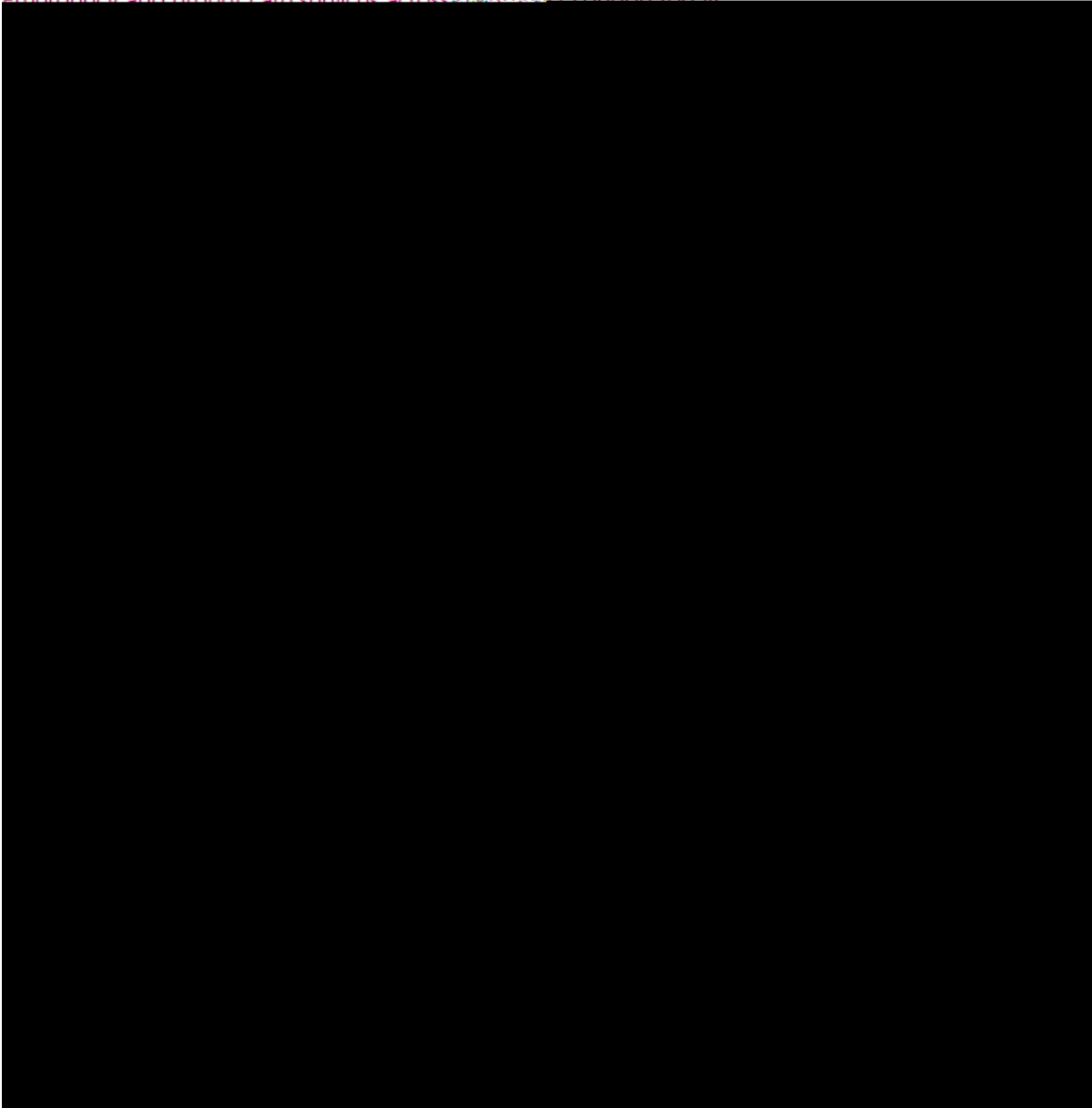

Given the proposals to move location of some services we will ensure that patients are still able to access services within reasonable travel times and that changes are



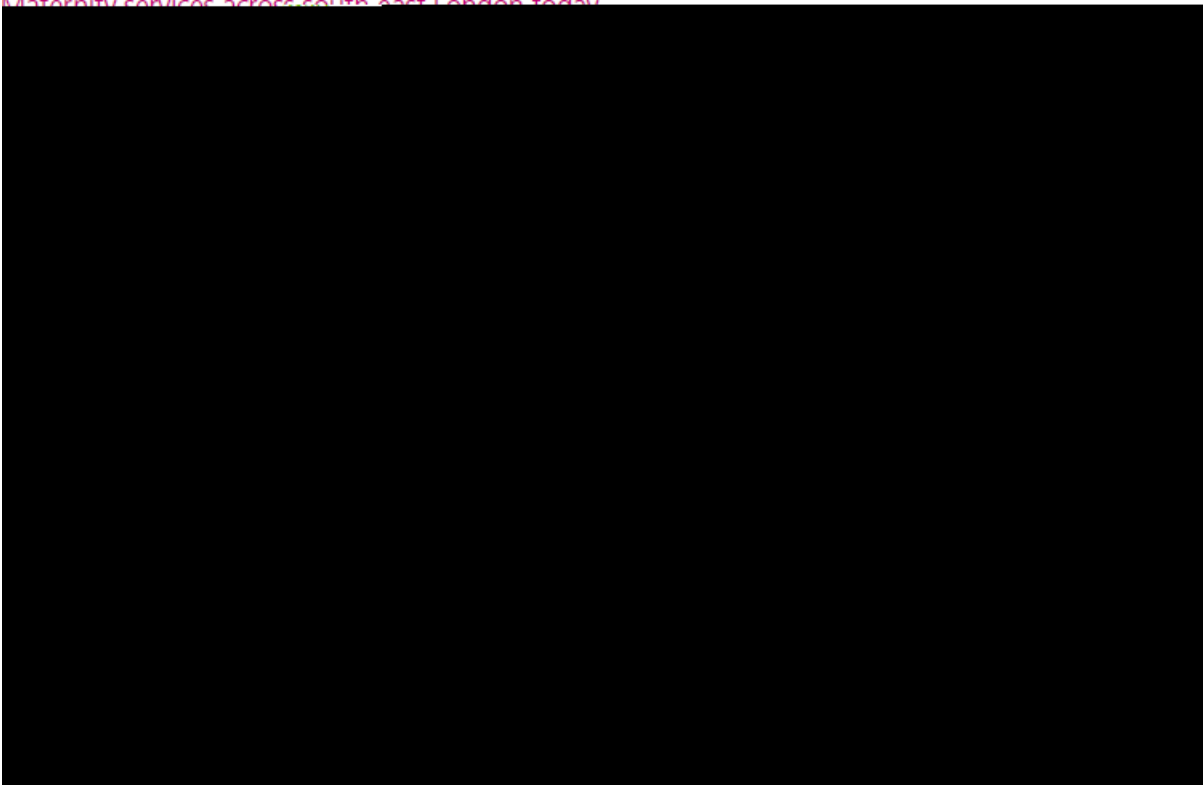
Appendix 1: Changing services in South East London TSA proposals at November 2012
