


Good record keeping is essential in delivering safe and effective nursing care and treatment, regardless of whether the recording system used is paper-based or electronic. The principles for recording are well established and fundamentally the same for both types of record keeping. These principles underpin the requirement within the NMC code (2018) (section 10), which states that registered nurses must: "keep clear and accurate records relevant to your practice".
